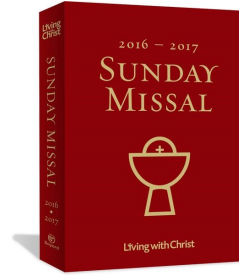
WANTED! HOSPITALITY CO-ORDINATOR

WEEKLY PRAYER REFLECTION

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

In 1925, Pope Pius the XI instituted the Feast of Christ the King — properly known as the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe since 1969 when Pope Paul VI gave it a new name. On this particular feast day, we are encouraged to remind ourselves that we must place God first in our lives and that everything else will follow.

"The faithful, moreover, by meditating upon these truths, will gain much strength and courage, enabling them to form their lives after the true Christian ideal. If to Christ our Lord is given all power in heaven and on earth; if all [people], purchased by his precious blood, are by a new right subjected to his dominion; if this power embraces all, it must be clear that not one of our faculties is exempt from his empire. He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things, and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls, or to use the words of the Apostle Paul, as instruments of justice unto God." (*Pope Pius XI, Quas primas, §33, Libreria Editrice Vaticana*).

Prayer to Jesus Christ our King

O, Lord, our God. You alone are the Most Holy King and Ruler of all the Universe. We pray to You, Lord, in the great expectation of receiving from You, O Divine King, mercy, peace, justice and all good things. Protect, O Lord our King, our families and the land of our birth. Deliver us from every evil and strengthen us against all temptations so that our lives may be filled with Your Grace of Joy, Happiness and Health. Forgive us, O Sovereign King, our sins against you and others. Jesus, You are a King of Mercy. Have mercy on us, Lord, that we may attain what we seek... (*Pause and place your Intentions here*) from the Abundance of Your Grace. O most awe-inspiring King, we bow before You and pray; May Your Reign, Your Kingdom, be always recognized on earth. Amen.
